

CPR/First Aid Training Quarterly Schedule

Students will learn Adult, Child and Infant CPR w/ AED and Choking care. Upon completion of the CPR training, students will receive a wallet-sized CPR certification card through the National Safety Council. The CPR card will be valid for 2 years.

Students will also learn about bleeding control, burns, shock, poisoning, hot and cold emergencies, fractures, seizures, diabetic emergencies, insect bites, and other life-threatening emergencies.

Upon completion of the First-Aid training, students will receive First-Aid Manual and a First-Aid Card valid for 2 years.

Class Fee

\$30.00 per person payable to: *WMA Fire & Rescue Department* at the start of class.

Class size is limited to 10 students for open enrollment.
(A minimum of 5 students will be needed to conduct the course)
