

CPR/First Aid Training

Course Description

Students will learn Adult, Child and Infant CPR w/ AED and Choking care. Upon completion of the CPR training, students will receive a wallet-sized CPR certification card through the National Safety Council. The CPR card will be valid for 2 years.

Students will also learn about bleeding control, burns, shock, poisoning, hot and cold emergencies, fractures, seizures, diabetic emergencies, insect bites, and other life-threatening emergencies. Upon completion of the First-Aid training, students will receive First-Aid Manual and a First-Aid Card valid for 2 years.

Course fee is \$30.00 per person. Cash only please.

Class size is limited to 10 students for open enrollment.
